# ASB/crime/criminal damage

### Denne -

- 2 x Joint patrol with Police Community Support Officers (PCSO).
- Joint patrol with Covid Information Officers.
- Spoke to groups regarding Parkour and informed them it is banned in the town centre and had them stop (Carfax, Chart Way). Parkour is a breach of the Public Space Protection Order (PSPO) conditions in the town centre
- Police made aware of a group of known individuals causing ASB (antisocial-behaviour) in the town.
- Shared intelligence with the PCSOs about the whereabouts of a known person involved in ASB.
- Spoke with Esquires regarding recent ASB experienced in the area and how to target harden the shop (Forum).
- Following an increase in the number of false fire alarm activation at the Forum, we reviewed CCTV from the residential area of the Forum. Images were passed onto the PCSOs but unfortunately were not clear enough to identify those featured.
- Police report made for evidence of a fire in the Garden of Remembrance. There was a collection of paper towels that looked like they had been set fire to but was extinguished at the time we came across it.
- Police report made for an individual breaching their Community Protection Notice (CPN) conditions (a legal document outlining prohibited conditions). A statement was provided to the police and a further report was made for an additional breaches witnessed.
- Intelligence shared with the PCSOs concerning a person acting suspiciously in the town centre.
- Assisted a PCSO in removing a knife from a public premises that had been found by security staff so that it could be secured.

• A group were acting aggressively towards a vulnerable member of the public, who thought they may have seen a weapon on a member of the group. We called 999 to report, the police attended, it is believed that the potential weapon was a ball pump (Horsham Park).

# Parking/vehicles

#### Denne –

- Following a car accident in Swan Walk car park we assisted in directing traffic out of the car park.
- Requested vehicle owner details from the Driver Vehicle Licensing Authority (DVLA) following CCTV images
  of the antisocial use of a vehicle which is a breach of the PSPO. 2 fixed penalty notices were issued as a
  result. (Piries Place)
- Electric scooter user details reported to the police (Horsham Park).
- Challenged electric scooter users/informed they are illegal on public land:
  - o 1 x Market Square
  - o 1 x West Street
  - o 1 x Chart Way
- Spoke to a driver that tooted their horn at a pedestrian that had right of way regarding the anti-social use of a vehicle. A verbal warning was given for breach of the PSPO was given.
- Asked drivers to park elsewhere
  - 5 x Park Place (closed road)
  - 1 x Black Horse Way (parked on zig zags)
  - 1 x Forum (parking not allowed in the area in front of the shops)
- Parking alerts issued:
  - 1 x Park Place (parking on a closed road/on a bend)
- Operation Crackdown Reports:
  - 1 x vehicle parked on pavement (Queensway)
  - 7 x vehicles parked on closed road and corner (Park Place). The HDC Licensing team was also made aware as one was for a taxi.
  - 2 x vehicle parked on a bend/dangerous (East Street). 1 vehicle was also reported to the DVLA as it
    was being used on public roads but is registered as SORN.
  - o 1 x vehicle parked on roundabout (Piries Place).
  - o 1 x Lorry drove and parked against one way system (Copnall Way).

#### Forest –

- Hand delivered a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) to the address of a resident that breached the PSPO in June. The original FPN had been returned to HDC in the post.
- Contacted a care home over a water feature that is spraying onto the pavement (Compton's Lane). The fountain was adjusted to not spray on the pavement.
- Reported overgrown vegetation obstructing the view of the road (Compton's Lane). WSCC Highways provided an update to say the leaves will be cut back.
